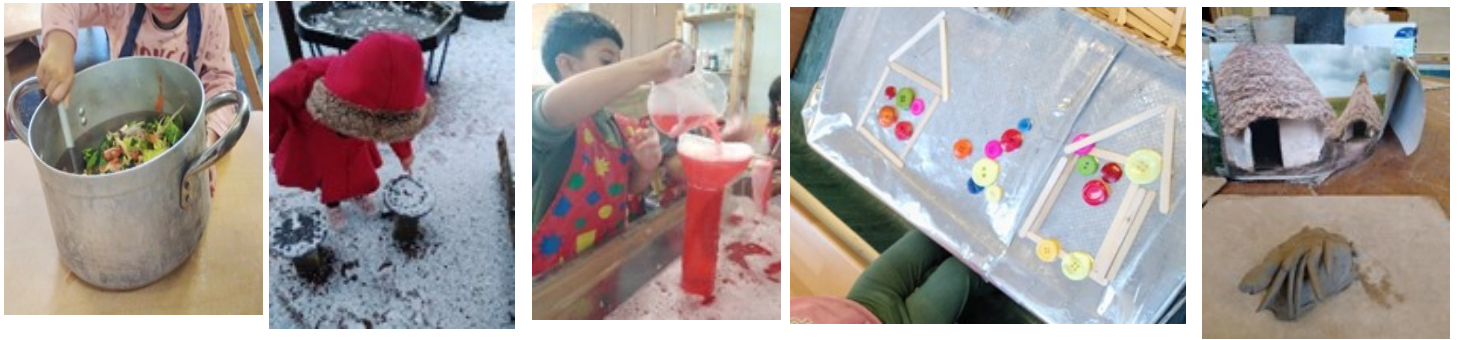


Washwood Heath Nursery School Spring 1 Newsletter 2023
